POSITION SUMMARY:

As a key member of the Information Technology team, the Application & Financial Systems Analyst is responsible for financial system application support, strategy and development for both Canucks Sports & Entertainment and the Aquilini Group. In addition, the incumbent will work closely with the Central Services management team to establish, improve and integrate processes and policies to ensure effective operations. The role manages the day-to-day operations as well as future planning and projection.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide technical and application support for all financial systems, including but not limited to the
 core financial reporting, document management, data warehouse, workflow applications, and any
 integration software associated to/from the systems, while ensuring system functionality aligns with
 company policy and procedure
- Provide support for operational issues concerning the financial systems, including troubleshooting, investigating, and solving operation system issues as they relate to financial transaction and information
- Develop and manage a financial system roadmap that identifies future enhancements/upgrades
- Support various internal teams using financial systems for reporting, forecasting, budgeting, and analysis
- Establish and manage project plans and teams to manage financial system maintenance and upgrades
- Perform configuration changes as appropriate to address user needs
- Ensure all team members have the training and knowledge required to utilize IT supported financial systems accordingly
- In cooperation with the divisional finance leadership, identify future needs and proactively plan for future upgrades and enhancements
- Work with outside consultants and application developers on customization and modifications to the existing systems
- Maintain data integrity, internal controls, and audit trails, ensuring maintenance throughout all applications
- Assist in testing functionalities, data reconciliation, creating and leading QA and end user testing
- Research, evaluate, and recommend new and emerging technology; maintain knowledge of current trends, practices, and advancements in the field
