By-Law No. 2 1993 - Amendment to By-Law No. 1 1992

Amendment to By-Law No. 1 1992 to modify the approval process pursuant to By-Law No. 1 1992

WHEREAS the Council of the Band wishes to modify the approval process set out in By-Law No. 1 1992; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Band is empowered to make such a By-Law pursuant to Paragraphs 81(1)(g),(q) and (r) of the Indian Act of Canada.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Band hereby enacts as a By-Law of the Band as follows:

- 1. <u>Definitions</u> All words and phrases used in the By-Law shall have the meanings set out in the Indian Act of Canada, unless otherwise specifically indicated in this By-Law.
- 2. <u>Amendment to By-Law No. 1 1992</u> By-Law No. 1 1992 is hereby amended as follows:
- (a) In Section 5 (first paragraph), the reference to "amendment to this By-Law" in the third line is to be deleted and replaced with "Band Council Resolution ("BCR")";
- (b) In Section 5 (last paragraph), the reference to "amendment" in the second to last line is to be deleted and replaced with "BCR"; and
- (c) In Section 6 (first paragraph), the reference to "an amendment" in the first line is to be deleted and replaced with "approval pursuant".

In all other respects, By-Law No. 1 1992 shall remain unchanged.

3. <u>Title</u> - This By-Law may be cited for all purposes as the "Burrard Indian Band Zoning By-Law No. 2 1993".

This By-Law is hereby made at a duly convened meeting of the Council of the Burrard Indian Band this 6th day of July, 1993.
