Hi everyone, we would like to inform you of some workplace procedures we have put in place to keep staff safe during this time.

TWN is working to ensure the health and safety and security of our community and staff as the COVID-19 situation unfolds. This includes following the advice and directives provided by the Provincial Medical Health Officer, Dr. Bonnie Henry.

- Stay home if you are sick
 - The B.C. [self-assessment tool](#) is available to help you
- 1 staff member per office until further notice
 - This means anyone sharing an office will have to stagger with other staff or work from home
 - Talk to your director about coming into the office in alternate hours (eg. 6am-1pm shift or 1pm-8pm shift)
- Keep social distancing
 - It is recommended you keep 2 meters between yourself and other people at all times
- The office will be closed to outside visitors until further notice
 - At this time, it is still open to employees and community
- The Skills Centre and TWN School is now closed until further notice
