On March 11, 2020 the World Health Organization (WHO) declaration of a pandemic of COVID-19 was announced, our risk has changed significantly. For that reason we, Tsleil-Waututh Chief and council, want to announce the postponement of all large sized gatherings and all Tsleil-Waututh Nation programs.

Tsleil-Waututh Chief and council's priorities are to ensure that our most vulnerable family members, elders, youth and those with other health conditions are protected. The measures are in place to minimize the potential risk of exposure. Taking lead from the direction of World Health Organization and the Regional Health Authorities we follow suite in being proactive in minimizing exposure to our valued membership.

We are working diligently to have current up-to-date information regarding COVID-19 virus transmission. Communications will be regularly posting information on the various TWN media outlets, E-mail, Facebook. In addition our Communication team will be sending out notices through door-to-door deliveries.

Tsleil-Waututh does have a Pandemic Plan that was developed in 2017. We are NOT in the phase to enact that plan at this time and will not need to unless otherwise directed by the government.

We understand this is a stressful time for all our community members. As we go forward together as a nation we will draw on our strengths to support one another in a good way.
