

Youth Summer Internship Opportunity! TLR & Fisheries and Oceans Canada on the Burrard Inlet Environmental Science and Stewardship Agreement

Fisheries and Oceans Canada (DFO; Science Branch; West Vancouver) is looking to hire a summer student or intern! The position would primarily be working with DFO biologists implementing the Burrard Inlet Environmental Science and Stewardship Agreement, on projects in Tsleil-Waututh Nation (TWN) territory and in collaboration with staff from TWN 'Treaty, Lands and Resources' Department. Specific duties could be tailored based on the candidates experience and/or interests, but would likely include: field work focused on clams, crabs, and environmental monitoring up the Indian River Watershed, as well as more office-based work such as data entry/summary, and equipment preparation.

Dates: Flexible, but likely to start sometime between May and September (2 - 4 month position) to coincide with the field season.

Essential Criteria: Undergo Government of Canada security clearance.

Assets: Able to conduct full days in the field including working on a boat; experience working with excel including data entry and summary; driver's license.
